Prior to joining Bradley Arant Boulton Cummings, Mr. Newsom served for three and a half years as the State of Alabama's Solicitor General, in which capacity he directed the state's appellate litigation in the U.S. Supreme Court, the United States Courts of Appeals, and the Alabama Supreme Court. He holds a J.D. (*summa cum laude*) from Harvard Law School and a B.A. (*summa cum laude*) from Samford University.
